Dirk Aaron is recommending the Board table this item until next month to give USGS and Baylor time to finalize their respective scopes and task orders. This is the 5th year for the District to participate in the MOA. The Board agreed to participate this year under the condition that other funding partners participate per the levels described in the draft proposed MOA. All entities have committed and already contributed funds to continue the work of the Coalition.

9. Discuss, consider and take appropriate action if necessary to elect Officers of the Board for calendar year 2018, per District Bylaws, Article V. Sec. 1.

Director, Gary Young, moved to keep the existing officers in place: Leland Gersbach – President, Wallace Biskup – Vice President, and Judy Parker – Secretary. Director, David Cole, seconded the motion. **Motion carried 5-0.**

10. Discuss, consider and take appropriate action if necessary to review and readopt the District Investment Policy for 2018.

Dirk presented the investment policy and corresponding resolution to the Board for approval. He noted that the policy provides direction, policy and daily operation needs of the District per Chapter 36 and the State of Texas Government Code per the Public Fund Investment Act. Annual review and re-adoption is required.

Dirk recommended the Board review the documentation and re-instate it. He commented that he and Leland Gersbach are the investment officers and attend the required training every other year.

Director, David Cole, moved to approve the District Investments Policy for 2018 subject to the resolution being signed. Vice President, Wallace Biskup, seconded the motion. **Motion carried 5-0.**

Staff was notified by the Auditor that an incorrect date is quoted in the minutes of the August 9, 2017 minutes regarding the date set for the public hearing to set the tax rate and budget for tax year 2017/budget year 2018.
